



Conditions for your visit to Monte Kali

When visiting the heap, the following points must be observed:

- > Visitors walk on the heap at their own risk.
- > The guide's instructions must be followed at all times, including in respect of keeping a safe distance from the heap's edge. Leaving the visitor group is not allowed.
- > A certain amount of physical effort is involved in walking up and down the heap, and it is essential that you are steady on your feet. Visitors are asked to assess their physical condition accordingly.
- > For safety reasons, visitors must wear sturdy shoes.
- > Visitors must be at least 6 years old. Children visiting the Monte Kali must be accompanied by an adult. The adult companion is liable for their children's behaviour.
- > Visitors must keep an adequate distance from all vehicles, machines, conveyor belts and electrical equipment.
- > For your visit to the heap, it is recommended that you wear clothes suited to the weather conditions.
- > You are not permitted to take any animals with you.
- > Anyone under the influence of alcohol or drugs is not allowed to take part in the visit.

The heap is owned by K+S Minerals and Agriculture GmbH and is under the control of the mining authority. K+S Minerals and Agriculture GmbH accepts no liability for any damage or loss to visitors' property.

ORGANISATIONAL DETAILS

Meeting point

The sole meeting point for the guided tours of the heap is 'Hexentanzplatz' outside of the heap fence. Walking or driving onto the heap lands unaccompanied by an authorised guide or residue heap supervisor is not allowed.

Cancellation due to bad weather

Except during storms, the guided tours take place in all weathers. For safety reasons, if stormy weather starts to approach, the tour will be aborted at once. In the event of heavy rain and/or very strong winds, the on-duty guide and on-duty residue heap supervisor will decide on site whether to cancel due to the weather. In this case, no charge will be made for the visit. Admission tickets already paid for will be reimbursed.

Cancellation of guided tours of the heap

Please appreciate that if you fail to cancel a tour that you have booked before the cancellation period has expired, you will incur costs due to our having booked a guide for your visit and made other advance organisational arrangements.

Visitor cancellation

Visitors can cancel a booked tour for free up until 12.30 on the Friday before it is scheduled to take place by ringing the Werra Kalibergbau Museum. If you as a visitor do not cancel your booked tour and fail to show up, the admission price times the number of people booked on the tour, plus a processing fee of €7.50, shall be payable and you will be issued with an invoice.

Rules for late arrivals

All tours start punctually at 10 a.m. (Sun; public holiday), 12.30 p.m. (Sat., Sun., public holiday) and 3 p.m. (Sat., public holiday). In the case of persons who arrive too late on the Hexentanzplatz, the claim to a guided ascent of Monte Kali.
